

ASSISTANT FIRE ALARM SUPERINTENDENT

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES Assists Fire Alarm Superintendent in installing and maintaining the Fire Department's alarm system; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is semi-skilled work involving responsibility for installation and maintenance of a fire alarm system. Work is performed under the immediate supervision of the Fire Alarm Superintendent.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

- Assists in the installation of fire alarm equipment such as switchboards, alarm boxes and aerial lines;
- Assists in the regular inspection and testing of fire alarm systems;
- Assists in making line changes;
- Assists in running lines and splicing cables.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Some knowledge of electrical installation methods; ability to perform line work; mechanical aptitude; willingness to work long hours in emergencies; conscientiousness and dependability; good physical condition.

ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Graduation from high school and one year of experience in electrical work; or any equivalent combination of experience and training.
