SKI AREA ATTENDANT

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Performs a variety of routine manual tasks in connection with the operation of the Town of Webb ski area; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is routine work involving responsibility for performing a wide variety of tasks such as performing minor repairs on ski tow equipment, operating rollers to pack snow on ski trails; collecting fees from ski tow users and general grounds maintenance work. These duties are performed under the general supervision of the Ski Area Manager.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative only)

- Performs minor repairs on ski tow equipment;
- Operates rollers to pack snow on ski trails;
- Collects fees from people using ski area facilities;
- Performs general grounds maintenance activities during summer months;
- Keeps records and makes reports;
- Help users on and off of ski lifts;
- Shovels snow;
- Performs miscellaneous laboring tasks.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Ability to read and write; ability to keep simple records; ability to give and enforce simple instructions; ability to perform manual labor; the ability to get along well with others; good physical condition.

ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: None is required.
